Student Eligibility Requirements.

As used in this rule, "relevant high school course" means a high school course that provides the appropriate academic foundation or career

- b) Has a cumulative unweighted high school grade point average of at least 3.00 and received an "A" or "B" grade in a relevant high school course.
 - c) Has a cumulative unweighted high school grade point average of at least 3.00 and received an "A" or "B" grade in a relevant high school course.
- 2) If a student is seeking to participate under section 3365.033 of the Revised Code and the student's cumulative unweighted high school grade point average is not available to the student under division (A)(1)(b) or (c) of this rule, the student is eligible if the student received an "A" or "B" grade in a relevant high school course.
- B) If a student's grade point average is calculated beyond the hundredths decimal point, the grade point average is rounded to the hundredths decimal point.
